Pages stay Sunday through Friday each week. Saturday is optional for the Host.



WHY HOST A PAGE?

- Support civic education and help young people engage in democracy
- Meet students from all over Washington
- Provide a safe and affordable home that contributes to a meaningful educational experience that lasts a lifetime



REQUIREMENTS

- All residents 18+ must pass a Washington State Patrol Background check
- Hosts agree to program guidelines and maintain a respectful environment
- Provide each Page their own bed
- Provide breakfast and dinner, lunch is optional

WHAT IS INVOLVED

- Provide a safe and welcoming home for one or more pages
- Provide breakfast and dinner for pages (lunch is optional)
- Supply a private room with individual beds and basic amenities (Pages may share a room with another Page)
- Provide daily transportation to and from the Capitol
- The work day begins at 7:30 am and wraps up at 4:45 pm
- Discuss expectations, schedule, and payment with parents/guardians

Typical Host Family charges to Pages:

- \$200 \$300 per week per PageAn additional \$50 \$100 if hosting on
- An additional \$50 \$100 if hosting or Friday night

Pages are paid a week after participating:

- Senate Pages receive \$67 daily
- House Pages receive \$65 daily
- Pages are eligible to receive a scholarship
